

We have assessed our practice for risks outlined and put in additional processes as detailed below

<b>Undertaken a risk assessment</b>	<p><i>Risk assessment undertaken on: 01/06/2020</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>We will review these processes as government or professional body guidance changes or every 4 weeks, whichever is sooner.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Heightened cleaning regimes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Clinic rooms will be cleaned between in each patient – including chairs, plinths, pillowcases and touch points.</i></li> <li><i>Common areas/washrooms will be cleaned every 4 hrs</i></li> <li><i>Touch points in common areas will be cleaned after every patient e.g. taps, banisters and door handles.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Increased protection measures</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Removed all linens from the clinic</i></li> <li><i>If you have introduced screens for reception areas, not to reopen until</i></li> <li><i>Practitioners to wear full PPE</i></li> <li><i>All Staff to wear PPE</i></li> </ul>
<b>Put in place distancing measures</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Practitioners in on different days, 15 mins between appointments, only 1 patient in the clinic at a time</i></li> <li><i>No reception cover or waiting areas, to increase social distancing and reduce contamination risk.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Staff training</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Correct handwashing technique best practice</i></li> <li><i>Put on/remove PPE safely</i></li> <li><i>Staff briefed and trained on updated clinic policies and infection measures</i></li> </ul>
<b>Providing remote consultations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>All patients will have telephone pre-screening call for COVID 19 and have risk explained to them prior to consultation.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Staff health</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Staff will monitor their temperature daily and immediately self-isolate and inform management if they develop Covid 19 symptoms.</i></li> </ul>
